

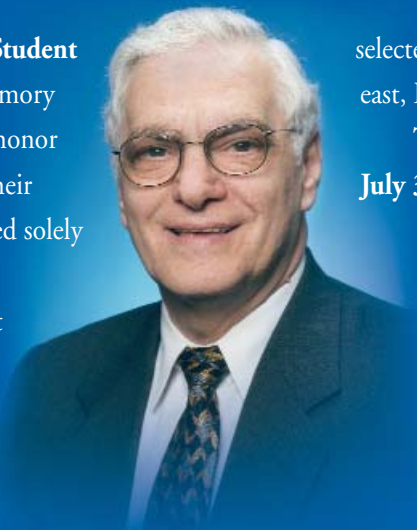
National Association of Postal Supervisors Vince Palladino Memorial Student Scholarships

2013 Official Application Form

The **Vince Palladino Memorial Student Scholarships** are awarded in memory of the late NAPS president and honor his dedication to NAPS members and their families. These scholarships are sponsored solely by NAPS.

Applicants for this scholarship must be the children or grandchildren of a living NAPS member, active or associate, at the time of drawing. Furthermore, the children or grandchildren must be attending or have been accepted by an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

NAPS will award 10 \$1,000 **Vince Palladino Memorial Student Scholarships**. Two winners will be randomly



selected from each of the NAPS regional areas (Northeast, Eastern, Central, Southern and Western).

This application must be received no later than July 31, 2013, at the address provided below.

Applicants may apply for both the **Vince Palladino Memorial Student Scholarship** and the **Donald N. Ledbetter Memorial Scholarship**, if they wish. However multiple applications from one individual for either scholarship will result in that candidate being disqualified from consideration.

Members whose child or grandchild have been awarded a **Vince Palladino Memorial Student Scholarship** will receive a check, payable to the college or university listed in the application, in late August 2013. Scholarships may be used to pay expenses in the student's current or following semester.
